AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 4, SEC. 6
CITATIONS FOR ORDINANCE VIOLATIONS

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has previously considered the matter and determined that citations for certain ordinance violations are to be issued by the police department currently contracted to provide police services to the village; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has previously adopted a deferred prosecution ordinance that permits any person charged with certain citations, the opportunity to avoid prosecution of the violation by paying a prescribed amount to the village; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined the amounts payable to avoid prosecution for the various offenses should be amended; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees have the power to pass this ordinance.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF GRIDLEY, MCLEAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS,

1. That the ordinances subject to deferred prosecution by issuance of a citation and the deferred payment amounts payable for violations under Sec. 6 of Chapter 2 of the Revised Ordinances of the Village of Gridley are hereby amended as follows:


2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect ten days from and after the date of its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form according to statute.
